

Innocenzo Cipolletta

Born on December 8th 1941, Innocenzo Cipolletta is Chairman of AIFI (Italian Private Equity, Venture Capital and Private Debt Association), Chairman of AIE (Italian Publishers Association), Chairman of InPiù SpA and Chairman of CCI (Confindustria Cultura Italia). He is also Deputy Chairman of FeBAF (Italian Banking, Insurance and Finance Federation) and board member of Assonime (Association of Italian Joint Stock Companies), Laterza SpA and CENSIS Foundation.

He has been Chairman of Assonime, FeBAF, UBS Investment Bank Italy, UBS Fiduciaria Italy, Fondo Italiano d'Investimento, Ferrovie dello Stato S.p.A. (the Italian state-owned Railways), Il Sole 24 Ore (daily financial newspaper), University of Trento and Marzotto Group.

He also held the position of General Director of Confindustria (the Italian Industry Association) from 1990 to 2000.

Cipolletta is a component of numerous Scientific Committees.

As a professor of economics, he has taught at the University of Rome "La Sapienza", the University of Reggio Calabria, the University of Florence "Cesare Alfieri" and the Roman University "LUISS-Guido Carli".

Innocenzo Cipolletta is a publicist and economics commentator of the newspaper Domani. He is also the author of many scientific publications and books and member of several non-profit organizations such as the Italian Statistics Society, the Italian Economists Society, Demographics and Statistics, the ISTAO (Istituto Adriano Olivetti per la Gestione Economica dell'Azienda) and of the Italian Institute for International Affairs (IAI).

Innocenzo Cipolletta has been appointed Cavaliere di Gran Croce in 1993.
