Seed Forum is a global meeting point for access to private equity funding in more than 40 countries worldwide. More than 10,000 investors are annually attending Seed Forums and more than 5,000 companies are annually trained in Seed Forums pitch trainings. The scope is to provide a high level of investor readiness to start-ups and the highest level of contact point between investors and companies. Seed Forum offers a free training day to startups on 7th April 2016, in which companies will learn negotiation techniques, the art of networking and will attend an investor readiness workshop.

Italian startups will have the opportunity of matchmaking with Norwegian startups. Why Norwegian? Because the Seed Forum is one of the official events in calendar on the occasion of the State Visit in Milan by Their Majesties The King and Queen of Norway.
